Life of an interim order

- 1. Either as provided under the statute
- 2. As per the directions given in the order itself

Judicious discretion in grant of interim orders

- 1. No interim relief unless there is main relief to the same
- 2. Prima facie case
- 3. Balance of convenience
- 4. Irreparable injury
- 5. Adherence to the Principles of natural justice
- 6. Assessment by the judge
- 7. Facts of the case
- 8. Security for performance
