Ans. A team of judicial officers has been constituted for preparing uniform nomenclature of case types for the subordinate courts. The report is yet to be submitted.

Ans. Under eCourts project:

- (i)one System Officer and one System Assistant for High Court,
- (ii) two System Officers for the Subordinate Courts.

The recruitment processed was done by the then Gauhati High Court.

Two more IT experts (1 System Analyst and 1 Programmer) have also been recruited recently by the High Court.

V. E-Filing and Video Conferencing

Ans. e- filing not yet started both in High Court or Subordinate Courts.

For video conferencing in subordinate courts: -

Video Conferencing equipments have been delivered in 12 court complexes and 2 jails in the State. But VC is operational in only 2 Court Complexes and the 2 jails. However, no remand proceedings have yet been done through VC. A team of judicial officers has been assigned for preparing proper guidelines for VC.

Video conferencing in High Court: -

Video conferencing is used for different purposes viz. (i) For judges' conference (ii) e-committee meeting etc.(iii) conference between other High Court and parties/litigants staying in the State on special request by other high court.

- 1. Filing at Judicial Service Center and generation of Receipt containing filing number.
- 2. Scrutiny objections on the District Court website.
- 3. Push SMS and E-mail facility on filing, registration, listing and disposal of case.
- 4. Single Window at JSC for filing of process fee and collection of dasti summons. E-mail summons can be generated in E-filing Cases.
- 5. Copies of Oral Evidence to be uploaded on Website, which can be downloaded by Lawyers/Parties after using login and password for their cases.
- 6. Template for writing judgments giving name of court, title, name of parties and date of filing of case.
- 7. Judgments are to be stored in the Server, which can be accessed by authorised persons from Court or Copying Agency etc.
- 8. Judgment on Internet Website with search facility.
- 9. Forms for generation of statements, reports and the registers in the prescribed format (abiding by the statutory requirement) to be made available on Intranet (LAN).
- 10. Automatic Caveat Checking.
- 11. Cause List on Internet (with Searchable Fields).
- 12. Court Diaries and Court Calendars to be generated automatically.
