




- Virtual Court (Spot Challan):







- provided scanning facility at e-filing counters.

Online e-filing

- Commenced on 13.06.2020
- Facility to e-file fresh cases as well as applications, replies, rejoinders, documents, etc. in pending cases.
- 1,24,684 cases have been e-filed till 20.09.2021 in District courts alone!

E-RTI & & E-LIBRARY DELHI HIGH COURT

- Dedicated Web Link https://dhcrti.nic.in/RTI/ for filing of RTI applications.
- Facility is in addition to the existing system of filing of RTI applications in physical mode.




IN-HOUSE

DELHI DISTRICT COURTS

- Launched Digital Court [N.I. Act] w.e.f. 17.11.2020.
- 34 Digital Court [N.I. Act] are functioning online in Delhi District Courts.
- Standard Operating Procedure (S.O.P.) is in place for paperless functioning of Digital Courts.
- More than **64,000 cases have been instituted** online through e-Filing in the Digital Courts as on 20.09.2021.
- N.I. Act Complaint Cases can be filed online through e-filing portal of Delhi District courts i.e. https://efiling-dl.ecourts.gov.in
- Court Hearings including recording of evidence is carried out via video conferencing.
- Documents, case history and other information concerning the case is accessed by Presiding officers through in-house developed LAYERS 2.0 Platform.
- Digitized/Softcopy casefile is made available to the Advocates and litigants online.

NSTEPDelhi District Courts





- •NSTEP Mobile Application is developed by the Hon'ble e-Committee, Supreme Court of India.
- •371 mobile phones already purchased and provided to the process servers in the District Courts.
- •NSTEP App is installed in all the mobile phones.
- •The electronic process generated by the Court through the CIS software is **automatically consumed in the NSTEP App.**
- •NSTEP captures signature, picture of receiver and geographical coordinates.
- Out station process can be shared with any of the District Courts across India. Service report is received electronically.
- Training has also been imparted on NSTEP Application


